Plethora of Runs

Fans of scoring, and plenty of it, should have enjoyed their experience at Paul Thomas this season. The AppleSox and their opponents have crossed home plate more this year than any other in the last decade, or the beginning of the West Coast League.

- Wenatchee is averaging 6.09 runs per game...previous high 5.81 in 2005.
- Opponents are averaging 5.55...previous high 4.36 last year.
- Combined runs are 11.62...previous high 9.85 in 2012.

- This year's 6.09 runs per game is second to 6.69 in 2004.

- This year's combined average of 11.62 is second to 11.83 in 2004.


August 10 Game
